Mayor's Award

This award will be presented by the Mayor of the City of Charlottetown to the owner of one city residential property in recognition of the overall improvement to their home and grounds.

Rules

1. The property must be located within the city limits and all improvements must be in compliance with City Bylaws.
2. Judges may redirect entries to a more appropriate category.
3. No members of the organizing committee, or of their immediate family are eligible to enter.
4. Public nominations are welcome but nominators are asked to include their own names.
5. No artificial flowers are permitted.
6. Judges reserve the right **not** to award a prize in any category.
7. The decision of the judges is final.
8. Only work done since last year's program will be considered except where noted.

Awards will be presented at the Communities In Bloom awards evening in mid July. Citizens are encouraged to nominate a neighbour whom they consider is worthy of an award in any of the categories.
